Albany City Code - Article I
Removal of Garbage
Sec. 313-8, Promulgation of Rules & Regulations

In accordance with section 313-8 of the Codes of the City of Albany, the Commissioner of General Services is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations as may be necessary to effectuate the provisions of Article I. The following rules and regulations are hereby adopted.

The provisions of section 313-4, titled Preparation And Placement of Household Refuse For Collection [amended 9-18-89], and the provisions of section 313-7, titled Penalties for Offenses [amended 12-20-1993], are hereby supplemented as follows:

All waste containers and waste stored in plastic bags for weekly pick up must be stored in areas away from front yards, sidewalks, or other public rights of way affecting the visual and aesthetic character of city streetscapes. Exemptions from these rules will only be permitted where no reasonable alternative methods or sites exist for the placement of weekly household garbage, or where hardships would exist should such exemption be withheld. Waste stored improperly in front yard areas, in violation of these rules, is subject to removal by the Department of General Services, upon the violator's failure, after posted or written notice, to do so.

These rules are hereby approved and adopted, effective this date, April 8, 1996.
